INCOMPLETE ENTRIES: Double Check all entries. Entries received without payment will not be processed. Entry changes or corrections may be made after March 8th but will be charged a \$10 fee per change or correction. Any change or correction made after March 22nd, **including onsite**, will be charged a \$25 fee per change or correction. All Correction fees are payable to Patti Conner. Fees must be paid in order for athletes to compete.

RULES: USA Gymnastics Trampoline & Tumbling rules from the current 2021-2024 Code of Points along with all errata pages (posted on USAGYM.org) will be used. Please note there are NO finals. All age groups are based on the age of the competitor on December 31, 2024.

ELIGIBLE ATHLETES: All athletes must be registered with USA Gymnastics.

All athletes must have attended a minimum of 2 eligibility competitions to be eligible to attend North State Championships. All athletes MUST attend both the State Championships and Regional Championships, and achieve the National score per event, in order to be eligible to attend the USA Gymnastics JO National Championships (Levels 8-Elite) June 21-26th in Minneapolis, MN and the Stars & Stripes Championships (Level 5-7) July 19-21st in Fort Worth, TX.

ATHLETE COMP CARD: Comp cards will be located at the Competition Office

Comp Cards must be turned in Friday, April 5, 2024

by 4pm or prior to the start of competition on Friday.

ELITE ATHLETES BIO: All gyms will be contacted by Athlete Rep (TBD). They will be reaching out to Elite Athletes for their Pictures and Bios to be posted on our Athlete Wall at State Championships

COACHES INFO: Only coaches who have completed ALL required courses and have a current USA Gymnastics Competitive Coach membership will be allowed on the competition floor. Please refer to the dress code in the Code of Points. The dress code for coaches will be strictly enforced.

New State Meet Awards:

Individual Event Awards - will be a ribbon given to all athletes, all levels at all events (formerly Flight Award).

Over-All Awards - will be medals given to all levels and age groups for all events.

High Performance Award - will be an award for 1st place only given to athletes in Levels 5-10/Open on each event. This will be the athlete with the highest score in their level on that event (boys and girls combined). Levels 1-4 will receive 1,2,3rd places.

Team Awards - Level 5-10/Open, 1st place only for each level, each event.
