**INCOMPLETE ENTRIES:** Double Check all entries. Entries received without payment will not be processed. Entry changes or corrections made after March 4th will be charged a \$10 fee per change or correction. Any change or correction made after March 14th, **including onsite**, will be charged a \$25 fee per change or correction. All Correction fees are payable to Patti Conner. Fees must be paid in order for athletes to compete.

**RULES:** USA Gymnastics Trampoline & Tumbling rules from the current 2021-2024 Code of Points along with all errata pages (posted on USAGYM.org) and NTXTT 2024-25 R&P will be used. **Please note there are NO finals.**

All competitor age groups will be determined by Competitors age as of December 31st. 2025.

**ELIGIBLE ATHLETES:** All athletes must be registered with USA Gymnastics.

All athletes must have attended a minimum of 2 eligibility competitions to be eligible to attend North State Championships. All athletes **MUST** attend both the State Championships and Regional Championships, and achieve the National score per event, in order to be eligible to attend the USA Gymnastics JO National Championships (Levels 8-Elite) June 16-21, 2025 in Providence, RI and the Stars & Stripes Championships (Level 5-7) July 10-13, 2025 - location to TBD.

**ATHLETE COMP CARD:** Comp cards will be located at the Competition Office

Comp Cards must be turned in Friday, April 4, 2025

by 4pm or prior to the start of competition on Friday.

**ELITE ATHLETES BIO:** All gyms will be contacted by Athlete Rep (TBD). They will be reaching out to Elite Athletes for their Pictures and Bios to be posted on our Athlete Wall of Honor at State Championships
